Transformational in understanding students living in poverty and equips educators with the tools and mindsets to truly make a difference for our students.

- Courses can be offered in semester/ module of choice, including Fall 1 or 2, Spring 1 or 2, and/or Summer 1 or 2. Dates are found here:

- Upon completion of both courses, educators receive 2 graduate courses eligible for recertification and earns the [Teaching Children of Poverty Endorsement from the South Carolina State Department](#) see p. 47
- \$6000 per course for up to 24 students, includes all textbooks and instructor
- Courses are 7 weeks, asynchronous, and if a full section (up to 24 students) is created, your team can take the courses together.
